

Burriss Central Leadership Program Evaluation Feedback Executive Summary

Family Feedback (15 responses)

- 100 % of respondents indicated they were very satisfied with the program
- Student Impact
 - Respondents indicated the program increased their student's communication skills, enhanced their confidence, and increased their involvement.
- Suggested Improvement
 - No clear theme emerged. Many respondents indicated "none."
 - Others suggested more parental notification, reviewing the time of day the program is offered, enlarging the program, keeping the program small, and looking for ways to allow students to fail.
- What Would They Share About This Experience?
 - The program promotes student growth, provides opportunities for cross-school networking, and allows the students to get involved in the community.
- Did the Program Impact Student Leadership Ability?
 - All but one respondent said yes
- Other Comments
 - Many expressed gratitude for the program and shared that the program should continue.

Student Feedback (11 responses)

- 82% were very satisfied (9 responses), 18% (2 responses) were satisfied
- 100 % of respondents agreed, or strongly agreed with the following statements:
 - I made friends / connections with students from another school.
 - The group projects were a good use of time and help me utilize the tools learned from throughout the program.
 - The summer trip to Camp Tecumseh was a good use of time.
 - I was engaged with what was going on in the sessions.
 - I utilized the resources website created by Mitch.
 - This program increased my leadership ability.
 - This program should be repeated in the future.
- 100 % of respondents rated the following elements as exceptional, or good:
 - Curriculum (The Things I Learned)
 - Instruction (How Well Mitch Taught)
 - Venues (The Places We Had Class)
 - Catering (The Food)
 - Networking (The Chance to Get to Know Other Students)
 - Overall Experience
- What Did They Enjoy Most About the Program?
 - Connections with other students was the most common theme
- Suggestions to Improve the Program
 - Many did not have any suggested changes
 - The most common suggestion was more meetings and more time together

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- Suggestions for Program Recruitment
 - There was no clear theme here. Responses truly varied.
- How Do You Explain this Program to Other People?
 - Responses varied but common themes include learning more about themselves, the value of gaining others input, the need to work as a team the importance of role modeling, and how to work in a group
- Other Comments
 - Many expressed gratitude for the program and their appreciation for the “teachers.”
